Ms Roxanna is the owner and creative director for the Dancin' With Roxie studio in both Hampton and Clear Lake. She was born and raised in Hampton, Ia. She starting dancing at the age of three and quickly discovered it was her one true calling. Roxanna was on competitive teams and won many high point awards in her competitive years. Roxanna also attend many workshops in her dance career. She has studied with famous dancer instructors including Mia Micheals, Shane Sparks, Laurie Ann Gibson, Jessica Starr, Jo Rowan, and Sarah Jo Fazio.

Roxanna attended North Iowa Area Community College (NIACC) after high school for two years where she received her Associates Degree and then continued her education at Iowa State University. GO State!

While at ISU Roxanna was a member of the Iowa State Pom Squad traveling to Shreveport, Louisiana for the Iowa State Bowl Game, Kansas City Big Twelve Tournament, and Daytona Beach, Florida for Nationals. Roxanna received her Bachelor's of Arts degree from Iowa State in Performing Arts with a Dance Emphasis.

Since opening Dancin' With Roxie in 2004, Ms Roxanna has had many accomplishments as a teacher and choreographer. In 2006 Hailey Huey, Richelle Orr and Anna Witt became Semi-Finalist for Sprout Division in the Bill Riley Talent Show at the Iowa State Fair. In 2008, Roxanna Johnson was asked to choreograph a Jazz Routine for the Clear Lake Dance Team. "As Fast As you Can" won Nationals with the Choreography Ms Roxanna created. In 2008-2009 Roxanna Johnson was also the Hampton-Dumont High School Dance Team coach and under her direction Clayton Velasquez won the Class II Dance State Champion. Clayton has also accomplished some other amazing things under Ms Roxanna direction. Out of 400 whom auditioned, Clayton was 1 of 25 who got accepted as Dance Major into the University of Arizona, the best dance college in the nation. Ms Roxanna was also given a best choreography award at Midwest Starz Dance Competition in Des Moines in March 2009.

COMPETITION TEAM

The DWR Competition Teams have won top awards in Ames, Des Moines, and Minneapolis. Competition Team is open to any DWR student. It is recommended the dancer participate in at least 2-3 years of combination classes before becoming part of the competition team. The Competition Team is showcased at the recital. DWR Competition Team travels to two competitions per year and an optional 3rd for all soloists.

The commitment of both the dancers and the parents is above and beyond those of the regular classes. Parents and student must be practicing more at home, traveling, taking care of preparing costumes, fundraising and much, much more. This program is not designed for everyone but for a select few who are willing to make the dedication to it. The cost of the Competition Team is significantly more than a regular class as well.

Mini Competition Team

These dancers meet once a week for an hour and compete with two dances at competition. Last Year's Mini Team consisted of 7 dancers between the ages of 6 and 9 years old. The new team will be competing in both tap and jazz category at Competition in the spring.

Junior Competition Team

These dancers meet once a week for an hour and a half and compete in Lyrical, Tap, and Jazz. Last Year's Team consisted of 9 dancers on the junior competition team all of middle school age. This age group is the hardest because their bodies are changing so fast. Please make sure your child is ready to work.

Senior Competition Team

These dancers meet once a week for an hour and a half and compete in Lyrical, Tap, Open, and Jazz. They had a team that consisted of 10 members. The senior team maybe a mixed age team of College and High School dancers. Senior Team is pushed to their limits weekly.

Solos/Duets/Trios

All of these options are available to members of the competition team. 6 hand-picked solos are offered to the team from Ms Roxanna. All other dancers may compete as a solo but routines will be choreographed by the other instructors at the studio.

The teams are set up every year to best fit the needs of the dancers. Team sizes and ages are always changing. If Competition Team is a track you would like to consider for your dancer please contact Ms Roxanna for more details.
